### Rocky Mountain College installs new active learning classroom

In January, Rocky Mountain College welcomed students to MK-125, a brand-new active learning classroom in Morledge-Kimball Hall. The classroom, funded by a generous grant from the Sunderland Foundation, supports the College's broader commitment to transformational learning. The new classroom features four conference tables, or learning stations, with seating at each for up to nine students. Each station includes a 55" flat screen monitor, connections for student laptops, and document cameras to enable projections from any device to any display, including the station monitors and large projection screen at the front of the classroom.
