RMC receives \$58,830 grant from M.J. Murdock Charitable Trust to study native river turtles of Montana

Rocky Mountain College received a \$58,830 grant from the M.J. Murdock Charitable Trust to support research into human impact on two species of native river turtles and river management methods to ensure species conservation.

RMC ranked No. 29 in NAIA Learfield IMG College Director's Cup

Rocky Mountain College finished No. 29th among 194 institutions for the NAIA Learfield IMG Director's Cup. The Battlin' Bears were given 448.00 points. Developed between the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and USA Today, points are awarded based on how an institution finishes at each of the NAIA's national championships. Eleven of Rocky's 12 participating athletic programs competed in national championships this year.
