II. POLICY In the event that the President is unable to execute the duties of the office for any reason, the Provost becomes Acting President until such time as the Board of Trustees ratifies the Provost as assuming the presidency until a search for a permanent replacement concludes successfully. In the event that the Provost is unable to execute the duties of the office for any reason, the Academic Vice President serves in a dual role as Academic Vice President/Provost until such time as a search for a permanent replacement concludes successfully. In the event that any of the Executive Vice President/Dean of Students, Vice President for Enrollment Services, or Chief Financial Officer are unable to execute the duties of the respective offices for any reason, the President will appoint a replacement until such time as a search for a permanent replacement concludes successfully.
