



2025-2026 Verification Worksheet for Independent Students

Your 2025–2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. In this process, RMC will be comparing your FAFSA information with the information on this worksheet and any other required documents. If there are differences between your FAFSA information and your financial documents, RMC will make the corrections and notify you in writing. The law requires the college to review this information before awarding Federal aid (34 CFR, Part 668). Complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit this form to the RMC Financial Aid office **as soon as possible** so your financial aid won't be delayed. **Verification must be completed no later than 14 days prior to the end of the first semester of enrollment. Failure to complete verification will result in the cancellation of all federal and institutional need-based aid. No federal loans or grants or institutional need-based aid will be disbursed until verification is complete.**
